- Mon/Wed/Fri AM or PM—\$175/month

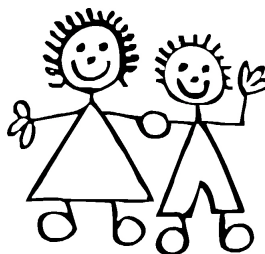
For children 4 by 9/1/2010:

Most of our classes have ten children with one teacher except for our youngest preschool classes who have an assistant at least through the first half of the year and our four day pm class which has 20 students with two teachers.

Some Special Extras

Regular and special Music time—Twice a week classes come together to sing and move to specially planned music. Several times per year, children meet to learn about musical concepts such as rhythm, tone, & vibration.

Art Masterpiece Program—Twice a year children learn about famous artists and have a chance to practice their techniques.

Learning Games Library—Weekly, parents may choose

from over 80 activities to enrich learning at home.

Field trips—Throughout the school year, off-site and in-house field trips are used to supplement learning.

Dad's & Mom's Nights—Each parent has a special evening to enjoy with their children...included language, artistic, and musical preparation by each student.
